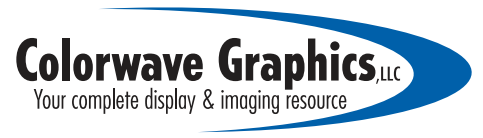

BEFORE INSTALLATION

_____ Dents, scratches, and other damages that were found on the vehicle are pointed out. Colorwave can not be held liable to any pre-existing damages.

_____ I have been explained and understand that the installation will reflect the condition of the paint of the vehicle.

_____ I understand that any dents or scratches to the paint of the vehicle may be visible and appear as bubbles or wrinkles on the material.

_____ I understand that seams and patches on the material may be necessary.

_____ I understand the following area cannot be wrapped:

- porous areas
- door jams
- rubber molding
- caulking-silicone
- windshield
- plastic trim
- driver/passenger windows
- chrome

_____ I understand this is a vehicle wrap and the color of the vehicle may show in these areas unless specified and agreed upon at the time of sale

- door jams
- behind bumpers
- bottom pinch welds
- vents/hole-slats
- in between bed & cap for pick-ups

_____ While Colorwave makes every effort to ensure consistent colors, I understand that there may be some slight color variations from panel to panel and vehicle to vehicle.

_____ I understand that vehicle wraps are meant to be viewed from 6-10 feet away.

_____ I understand Colorwave will not be liable for any paint damage occurring during installation.
